As a follow up to your request for information on your grandfather, George E. Hills, attached please find copies of a number of documents which you may find interesting.


First of all, there is a certified copy of his record of marriage to Charlotte E. Williams.

Secondly, your grandfather served on the Brookline School Committee from 1934-1949, and as chair from December, 1936-March, 1940 and again from May 1942-March 1949. I am including a summary of these dates, which note his election/re-election dates, and the date of his last meeting. There are also copies of the lists of elected officials to various boards from most of those years (some are missing), and some sample pages from the official public record of the School Committee meetings during his tenure. I tried to capture the flavor of some of his activities.

Thirdly, I've included an article on Ernest Caverly, who served as Superintendent from 1930-1965, as well as a brochure from 1935 entitled: *What to Study in Brookline High School*. (I apologize for the cut and paste job on that, but it was stuck to a huge bound book with very delicate pages!) You might find it interesting from a historical point of view.
